

Submitting Field Day 2020 Results to the ARRL

For N3FJP and other logging software:

The ARRL only needs the "DUP" file.

:: File > Write Cabrillo File

Important: Make darn sure you note WHERE the file is stored!!

:: ARRL has streamlined the submittal process, it's no longer necessary to complete the form that appears.

:: Click Write Dupe File button, then click the large Green button near the top that says "Click Here to Calculate Band Totals..." to proceed.

:: A form will display with your QSO totals by band.

:: At the Bottom Left of the form, click on the link to take you to ARRL submittal form

:: Complete your submittal, being sure to select the "Dup file" you just created.

(Remember WHERE you saved the file?!)

:: Fill in the Location for "YOUR callsign.dup" file.

Note: Please make sure your submission is identified with "**SARA MN**" so our club is associated with your Field Day contacts.

You'll find "**SARA MN**" in the Affiliated Club drop-down menu.

All the ARRL is looking for is a list of Callsigns, sorted alphabetically by band and mode.

This can be an Excel spreadsheet, a Microsoft Word file, a text file.

You can even write it out on paper and take a photo of it with a smart phone and attach it to the entry that way.

And, you can start the entry online, and mail it in as supporting documents.
